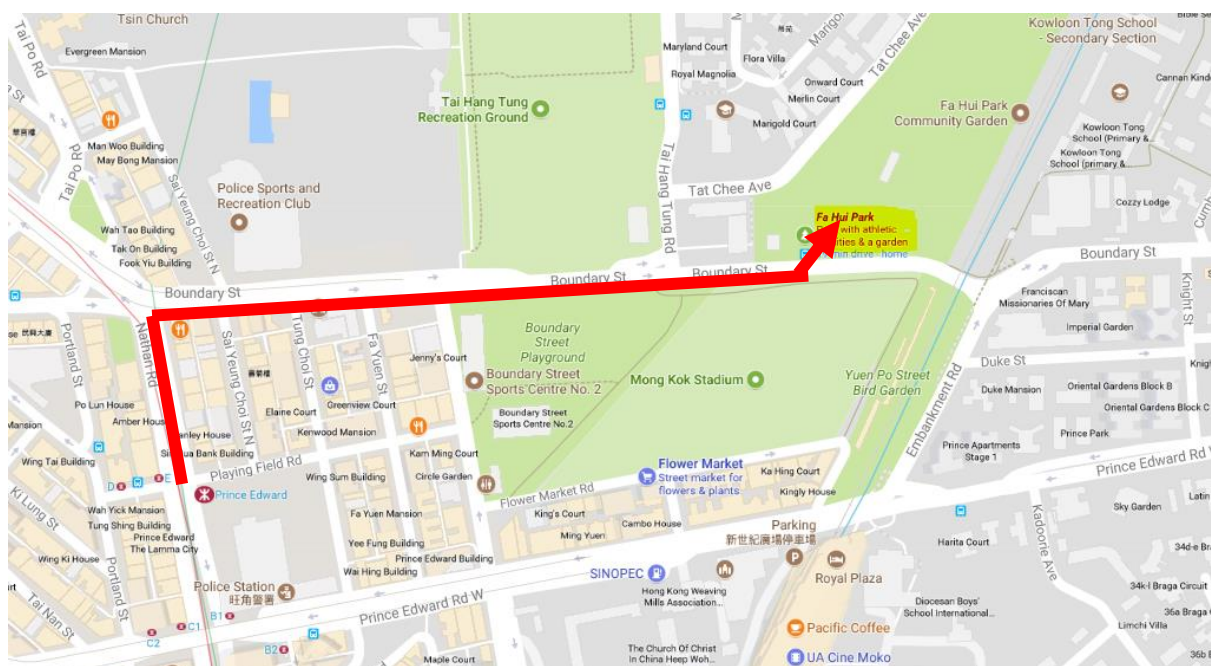

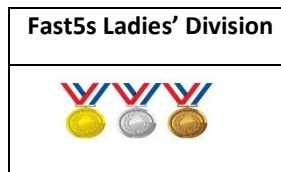

2. Umpires

If your team did not pay the umpiring levy, you must provide your nominated qualified umpire to umpire your duty. Failure to do so will result in fines at \$100 per game or competition points deducted from your team. In some cases, event officials may withdraw the team from further competition. Your nominated umpire must be a qualified umpire who at bare minimum, are qualified to umpire at Junior Netball League. Please note that due to different in structures in the format for each category, some teams in another category may have more or less umpiring duties. Your number of umpiring duties will not exceed the number of games you played.

In line with HKNA bylaws, umpires must be wearing a white top for their duties.

If you have selected to pay for the umpiring levy, umpiring levy should have been transferred to HKNA already. Please send receipt of transaction.

3. Competition points system for 7-a-side and Fast5's.

Three points shall be awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw, 0 point for a loss during the round robin matches. If a game is drawn at the end of regulation time for play-offs matches, then the match will go into 'golden goal' situation where the team who scores the next goal will win that match. The team who's has the next centre pass will start play.

- If two teams tie on points, the winner will be decided by:
 - The result of the match played between the two teams involved will be used to determine the placing.
 - If the match was a draw, the goal average in matches of the teams played in the group will be used to determine the placing.
- If three or more teams tie on points, the winner will be decided by:
 - The goal average among teams concerned will be used to determine the placing.
 - If still tied, the goal average in matches of the teams played in the group will be used to determine the placing.

- The goal average for each team shall be decided as follows.
 - The total number of goals scored by the team, divided by the total number of goals scored against the team, multiplied by 100 and divided by the actual number of matches played (above-mentioned) by the team.

4. Uniforms/ Players

Each player shall wear the team uniform or wearing the same colour throughout the competition. Playing positions must be worn by each player of a team.

Each team is required to provide their own set of Bibs. Fast 5's – Teams are encouraged to bring 2 sets of matching bibs to aid with the transition of rolling subs.

Players are NOT allowed to wear any items of jewellery or sharp adornments. Medical bracelet, if worn, must be taped. Fingernails shall be cut short and smooth.

5. Equipment

HKNA will provide size 5 match balls for each court. Please provide your own training/warm up ball.

6. First Aid and Physiotherapy support

First aid officers will be in attendance on both days of the competition. It is recommended that each team to bring their own first aid kit, sunscreen, mosquito repellent and sunhats.



Joint Dynamics will be on site to provide strapping services, strapping demonstrations and strength and conditioning talk. They will be there all day on Saturday for strapping service and can provide tips and advice on injury prevention and treatment.

7. Food and Beverage

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE KIOSK AT FA HUI PARK IS CLOSED ON SATURDAY 29th SEPTEMBER. PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN FOOD AND DRINKS!!!!

8. Security

Unfortunately, there have been known stories of thefts occurring at Wong Chuk Hang Recreational Ground, so participants are recommended not to bring valuables to the venue. There will be a limited number of lockers for storing bags available in the venues toilets: you will need to provide your own lock.

HKNA will not be held liable for any damages or loss to your belongings during the weekend.

9. Registration

Each team nominated contact person will need to approach the registration desk during the allocated timeslot to advise they have arrived, ensure disclaimer forms have been completed and to collect the team's goodies bags.

Recommend team to have 2 sets of same color bibs for easier substitution.

Must have 5 players on court at all time.


SUBSTITUTION



Rolling substitutions will be used. A change can be made at any stage of the game, during a break or during play.


Player on court must tap the player on the sideline before he/she can come in.

CENTRE PASSES



The game will start with the team that wins rock paper scissors. Then all centre passes shall be taken by the team that did not score the last goal.


FAST 5 MIXED



The possible combinations for Fast 5 Mixed Category are:
1) 3 Boys and 2 Girls
2) 4 Boys and 1 Girl


No restriction in playing position

Two 7-minute quarters with 1-minute break time.


UMPIRING SIGNAL




1 point (left), 2 points (middle), 3 points (right).

GOAL SCORING

There are three different scoring zones in Fast5



3 points	The Super Shot made outside the goal circle, for the long-bomb specialists
2 points	A shot made in the outer circle, for those who want to be a little more daring.
1 point	A goal scored in the inner circle, the safer option.
