A General Meeting to be called the Annual General Meeting shall be held once in each financial year at such time and place as the Executive Council shall determine provided that an Annual General Meeting shall be held not more that 15 months after the holding of the last preceding Annual General Meeting. Provided that so long as the Association holds its first Annual General Meeting within 18 months of its

incorporation, it need not hold it in the year of its

incorporation or in the following year.

Extraordinary General Meeting

56. The Executive Council may convene an **Extraordinary General Meeting** whenever it thinks fit. The Executive Council shall also upon requisition in writing signed by Members representing not less than one tenth of the total voting rights of all Members, within 21 days of the date such requisition is received, convene an Extraordinary General Meeting to be held within 28 days of the date on, which such notice of Extraordinary General Meeting is given to Members entitled to attend and vote at such General Meeting. The Requisition shall clearly set out all resolutions to be proposed at the Extraordinary General Meeting. If the Executive Council fails to take the necessary action within the prescribed time, Members representing not less than one tenth of the total voting right of all Members may themselves convene an Extraordinary General Meeting and for this purpose shall have access to such records of the Association as will enable them to convene a meeting.

General Meeting
