MINUTES OF MATTERS DISCUSSED

1. Review of March's minutes

2. President's Report (KE)

- CEO recruitment has started. Ten first-round interviews. The second round of interviews has begun. Good variety and quality of candidates
- Updated the committee regarding AR's situation. Shirley Yuen will fill in for AR on the committee as JNL convenor.
- 8 and 15 May booked for JNL fun day. 8th May can be used for teams to join some training. 15th May free one-day JNL fun day tournament
- Asian Championships 3 -11 September in Singapore is confirmed. Hopefully, HK will ease restrictions so the squad can train again.
- 25th Anniversary of HK HKJC offered all the NSA to run a community event. HKFA will lead a day collaborating with other 'ball' sports to do a joint multi-sport community event. An excellent way to connect with people who we don't usually reach.
- Mixed League preparations need to start

3. Office & Events Manager's Report (LP)

- Although LCSD venues are beginning to open up, unfortunately, not that many venues with netball lines are re-opening.
- HK Park will be closed for May and June as they are the backup venue for the CE election,
 - o affecting the National Ladies Squad as that's their main training venue

- Office is actively looking for other venues. Hong Kong Games are cancelled, so hopefully, more venues will become available
- National Ladies squad will use the Academy training on Saturday mornings in May
- KE suggests looking at schools. SY will check with Kellett.
- The 25th Anniversary event will feature rugby, cricket, Kinball, baseball, lacrosse, Gaelic football, and flying disc. The dates are 20th and 21st August 2022. HKFA had submitted an application for funding to LCSD on 25th March. KE - we need volunteers (preferably able to speak Cantonese) for this event. Budget to pay some money for volunteers
- LCSD training workshop on the compilation of staff administration policy for subvented NSAs. LP has provided supplementary documents to the committee members if they are interested in learning more
- LCSD has not confirmed whether subvented programs can resume. The office has been chasing LCSD

4. Elite and Coaching Updates (CW)

- Hopefully the session on Friday 22 April can go-ahead for the National Ladies Squad
- As mentioned in the last meeting, all the venues and resources will focus on the National Ladies Squad from now until Asian Championships

 may affect the player's availability. There may be a possibility that we may not have enough
 players available, and in that case, we may look to invite other players into the squad.
- Coaches of HKNA elite programs (National and Academy) have been invited to join some online coaching workshops. A workshop on developing culture and conducting specialist training. HKNA covered their fees.
